Ladies and gentlemen,

Today, I am excited to share updates about our church project to remodel the back wall of our sanctuary. As you may know, this project was originally scheduled to start in April but we faced delays due to the masonry subcontractor's prior commitments. However, we are pleased to announce that construction will now commence on **June 8th** and is expected to be completed by **July 17th**. During this time, we will need to navigate some changes. There will not be any weekday masses in the church, but Father Kris is actively coordinating with the diocese to ensure that daily masses will be available at alternate locations or alternate times. As the work begins, dust barriers will be set up around the church for containing the mess; however, on weekends, these will be pulled back so that we can still gather for our Saturday and Sunday masses.

Father Kris will also be making arrangements to temporarily relocate the Eucharist to a Tabernacle outside the church Sanctuary during the weekdays. This means that the church will be closed to parishioners during the week while the project is in progress.

In the first week of the project, we will take on the task of removing the existing wall panels ourselves, and we are asking those who have the ability help with the removal to please volunteer, look out for further details in the church bulletin. Please remember that the diocese has specified certain requirements: volunteers must be trained and at least 16 years old and equipped with safety shoes, glasses, and hard hats while working. We will organize a work schedule to accommodate various times and ensure we can efficiently remove all the panels.

Once we complete the initial phase, the contractors will begin implementing all the requested changes, with a planned completion time of about a month.

If you have any questions or concerns throughout this process, please don't hesitate to reach out. My contact information will be available in the bulletin.

Thank you all for your understanding and support as we work together to enhance our church. Let us continue to pray for the success of this project and for our parish community.

Damas y caballeros:

Hoy me complace compartir actualizaciones sobre nuestro proyecto parroquial para remodelar la pared trasera de nuestro santuario. Como saben, este proyecto estaba originalmente programado para comenzar en abril, pero enfrentamos retrasos debido a compromisos previos del subcontratista de mampostería. Sin embargo, nos complace anunciar que la construcción comenzará ahora el 8 de junio y se espera que finalice el 17 de julio. Durante este tiempo, tendremos que adaptarnos a algunos cambios. No habrá misas entre semana en la iglesia, pero el Padre Kris está coordinando activamente con la diócesis para asegurar que las misas diarias estén disponibles en ubicaciones o horarios alternativos. A medida que comiencen los trabajos, se instalarán barreras contra el polvo alrededor de la iglesia para contener los escombros; sin embargo, los fines de semana se retirarán para que podamos reunirnos para nuestras misas del sábado y domingo.

El Padre Kris también hará los arreglos necesarios para trasladar temporalmente la Eucaristía a un tabernáculo fuera del santuario de la iglesia durante los días de semana. Esto significa que la iglesia estará cerrada a los feligreses entre semana mientras el proyecto esté en curso.

En la primera semana del proyecto, asumiremos la tarea de retirar nosotros mismos los paneles de pared existentes, y estamos solicitando a quienes tengan la capacidad de ayudar con esta labor que se ofrezcan como voluntarios. Por favor, estén atentos a más detalles en el boletín de la iglesia. Recuerden que la diócesis ha establecido ciertos requisitos: los voluntarios deben estar capacitados, tener al menos 16 años de edad y contar con calzado de seguridad, gafas protectoras y cascos mientras trabajen. Organizaremos un horario de trabajo para adaptarnos a distintos tiempos y asegurar que podamos retirar todos los paneles de manera eficiente.

Una vez que completemos la fase inicial, los contratistas comenzarán a implementar todos los cambios solicitados, con un tiempo estimado de finalización de aproximadamente un mes.

When: July 20-25, 9:00-2:30 (entering gr. 1-6) and July 19-23, 7 pm- 9 pm (entering gr. 7-12)

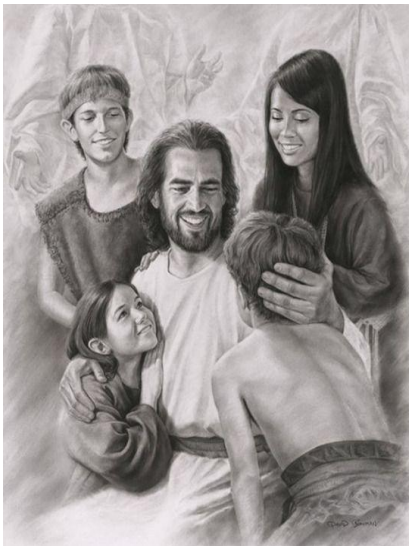
Who: It is Catholic, but we encourage youth of all faiths or no faith to attend.
